

A fundamental change in thinking what society IS, and what it means to be an active part of it.


- New objectives for health and care








#### The Silver Economy

Ageing as a source of jobs and growth

- Global Silver Economy market estimated at \$ 7 trillion per year
- Ageing-related spending equals 50% of total government expenditure and 25% of GDP. And spending is increasing...
- "Baby boomer" spending power will reach \$ 15 trillion by the year 2020
- 1 million new healthcare jobs by 2020
- A potential 1,5 million new jobs through implementation of sustainable employment models






## Synergies? There just might be...




